

**HAN VO-TA** received his Bachelor of Science (1972) and Master of Science (1973) in Management both from the Alfred P. Sloan School of Management, Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) majoring in Corporate Strategy, Planning and Control, International Business and Economics Development. He was also recipient of two prestigious awards from MIT namely the 1972 Sloan School of Management Samuel Burke Prize for "... an outstanding student in the field of management with high scholastic standing, leadership and professional promise" as well as the 1973 William L. Stewart Award for "outstanding contributions" to MIT.

Upon graduation, he worked with Bank of Montreal, Canada for 12 years in International Credit, Corporate Financial Planning, Project Financing, International Representative Office, International Branch Operations and Merchant Banking in Montreal, Toronto, Manila and Singapore.
